Introduction	 Introduction (project background) Problem statement Embed in the Problem Statement to relate project with PO6 (Engineer and Society – societal and global issues (health, cultural, etc) and PO7 (Environment and Sustainability, which includes Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by United Nations) Objective Scope
Literature Review (LR)	 Academic publications (journal/articles/textbook) – MUST Product Research (patent research) - option Potential customer or potential user survey/feasibility study – option Investigate into existing systems/techniques/technology that are closely related and comparison between them.
Methodology	 Provide general (from literature review until project completion) and specific (hardware, software, integration) flowcharts to explain the associated processes/methods needed to achieve that objective/milestone. Block diagram to explain the illustration of the project (experimental setup, hardware arrangement) Design procedure of project
Results and Discussion	 Provide summarization of data collection, data trend, etc in table, graph, etc. A minimum of 3 analyses must be carried out (depending on project's nature) Example: Data validation (developed prototype compare with another real measured data) Comparison between techniques/methods
Conclusion	 General conclusion of the project Recommendation - recommendation for future work (improvement etc) related to the project) Project potential - project commercialization potential/practical application/community needs
References	 Most (80%) of references must be recent 5 years Citation - Avoid excessive citation work in report. Any info taken from any resources must be cited (tables, illustrations, etc.) A minimum of 20 reliable references must be cited in the report. Provide ways to cite multiple resources (book, website, newspaper, textbook) Provide portion for each type of references. Academic articles (journal/proceeding) min 50% Website not more max 20% (not recommended) Textbook Wikipedia and similar unreliable resources are not accepted.
